FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant herein, having received authority, under Decision No. 19282, in Application No. 14331, and Decision No. 19417, in Application No. 14355, to construct a track at grade across the main line track of the Pajaro Valley Consolidated Railroad Company and across Cattlemen's Lane in the City of Salinas, both of said crossings being in the immediate vicinity of crossings of said railroad and said Cattlemen's Lane heretofore authorized in this proceeding, and it appearing that when the crossings authorized in said Decisions No. 19282 and No. 19417 are constructed, the crossings heretofore authorized by Decision No. 18182 in this application will no longer be required and can be removed, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that if and when the crossing of the track of Pajaro Valley Consolidated Railroad Company, heretofore authorized in Decision No. 19282, and the crossing of Cattlemen's Lane, heretofore authorized in Decision No. 19417,

are constructed and placed in operation:

1. The crossings of the track of Pajero Valley Consolidated Railroad Company and of Cattlemen's Lane, authorized in Decision No. 18182, in this application, shall be abolished and the tracks removed; and,

2. Said Decision No. 18182 shall be revoked and Application No. 13607 dismissed.
