SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Fred Duffy, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 16877, dated June 10, 1926, and issued on Application No. 12685, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto trucking service on demand between Point Arena and Devilbiss Ranch and intermediate points has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of March 15, 1928, that he did not operate during the year 1927, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Fred Duffy by said Decision No. 16877 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Fred Duffy shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in his name with the Railroad Commission, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
