BY THE COMMISSION:

SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, in Decision No. 9839, (20 C.R.C.948) this Commission provided with reference to Schedules "A" and "B" of Modesto Gas Company, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of 2.6 cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$2.00 per barrel F.O.B. Modesto; and

Whereas, Modesto Gas Company now makes affidavit that the price paid for oil has been further reduced ten (10) cents per barrel to \$1.25 per barrel in Modesto which is seventy-five (75) cents per barrel below the base price upon which rates were established in Decision No.9839,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Modesto Gas Company reduce its rate designated as Schedule "A", effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after April 15, 1928, so that said rates shall be twenty (20) cents per thousand cubic feet or less than the basic rate established in Decision No.9839.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Modesto Gas Company file with this Commission on or before April 10, 1928, a revision

of its schedules to comply with this order.
