ORDER

This is an application of the American Railway Express Company for authority to abandon its agency at Cement, in the County of Solano, State of California.

The Town of Cement is served by the Cement, Tolenas and Tidewater Railway Company. This Company has recently applied to this Commission for permission to discontinue passenger train service and cancel its passenger tariffs, Application No. 14,466. Authority for such discontinuance of passenger train service and for the cancellation of passenger tariffs was granted the Cement, Tolenas and Tidewater Railway Company on the 19th day of March, 1928, Commission's Decision No. 19,494. It appears to this Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be, and it is hereby granted to the American Railway Express Company to abandon its agency at Cement, County of Solano, State of Califor-

nia, upon one (1) day's notice to the public and to the Commission, and to so amend its tariffs.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
