FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 19242, dated January 11, 1928, the Commission authorized the Stockton and Mokelumne Canal Company, a corporation, to sell its properties, referred to in said decision, to the Woodbridge Irrigation District, for the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars.

On April 11th the Stockton and Mokelumne Canal Company filed a supplemental petition in the above entitled matter in which it asks the Commission to modify the order in Decision No. 19242 so as to permit it to sell its properties for Two Hundred and Forty-six Thousand Four Hundred and Four (\$246,404.00) Dollars.

It appears that the sale of the company's properties for \$246,404.00 was approved by the owners and holders of record of

more than two thirds of the issued capital stock of the corporation. The Commission has considered the request of applicant, Stockton and Mokelumne Canal Company, and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's order in Decision No. 19242, dated January 11, 1928, be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out of that portion of the decision constituting the order, the words and figures as follows, to-wit: "Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof "Two Hundred and Forty-six Thousand, Four Hundred and Four Dollars (\$246,404.00)."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 19242, dated January 11, 1928, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
