ORDER

This is an application of the Southern Pacific Company for authority to abandon its Shellmound Park Station in the County of Alameda, State of California.

This station was originally used by the patrons of Shellmound Park. However, this park has ceased to exist and the territory is now being built up with industries. There is located a station at Emeryville, approximately 0.2 miles west of Shellmound Park Station, and another approximately 3.2 miles east thereof.

It appears that the station at Shellmound Park is no longer necessary; that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary; and, that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Shellmound Park, located on the Shattuck Avenue Line of its East Bay Electric Division in Alameda County, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel in conformity with the rules of

this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules covering such station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
