SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Long Beach Transfer & Warehouse Company, a corporation, has advised the Railroad Commission, in writing, under date of April 6, 1928, that on December 31, 1927, it discontinued operation of the trucking service between Los Angeles and Long Beach it was authorized to perform by Railroad Commission Decision No.14839, dated April 25, 1925, and issued on Application No.9724, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Long Beach Transfer & Warehouse Company by Decision No.14839 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Long Beach Transfer & Warehouse Company shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in its name with the Railroad Commission, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
