In the Matter of the Application of CHARLES GULLING to sell a water system and the Portola Water Company, a corporation, to purchase a water system.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Charles Gulling, owner and operator of the Northern Portola Water System, having made application to this Commission for authority to transfer to the Portola Water Company, a corporation, a public utility water system supplying consumers in the Town of North Portola, Plumas County, and the Portola Water Company having joined in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charles Gulling be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to the Portola Water Company his public utility water system supplying consumers in the Town of North Portola, Plumas County, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission, or any other public body, as a finding of value for rate-fixing, or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1928, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Charles Gulling within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
3. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Charles Gulling actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
