ORDER

Fortuna Water Company, a corporation, having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer to Town of Fortuna, a municipal corporation of the sixth class, a certain public utility water system supplying water for domestic and municipal purposes to consumers within the corporate boundaries of said town, and the said Town of Fortuna having joined in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Fortuna Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to Town of Fortuna, a municipal corporation, that certain public utility water system supplying water for domestic and municipal purposes to consumers within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Fortuna, Humboldt County, and as more particularly

described in the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1928, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Fortuna Water Company within thirty (30) days of the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days of the date on which Fortuna Water Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
