SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record and the order entered in the above entitled proceeding, March 10, 1928, and good cause appearing therefor

IT IS ORDERED that said order of March 10, 1928 be and the same is hereby amended so as to provide that defendants be and they are hereby authorized and directed to refund to Hunt Brothers Packing Company all charges they may have collected in excess of 15½ cents per 100 pounds on 26 carloads of fresh fruit moved from Empire to Hayward during August, 1926 together with interest at the rate of 6% per annum.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said opinion and order of March 10, 1928 shall continue in full force

and effect.
