## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to operate its tracks in the vicinity of First Street in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, with clearances which do not conform to this Commission's General Order No. 26-C, and it appearing that it is necessary that such impaired clearances be maintained during the construction of a new viaduct carrying First Street over the tracks of this company, which is now being constructed under authority granted by this Commission in Decisions No. 18569 and No. 19030, in Application No. 9671, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request is reasonable and should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that until September 30, 1928, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to operate certain of its tracks, as shown on blue print attached to the application, in the vicinity of First Street in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, with clearances as follows:

subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That proper notices of warning shall be posted on each side of said impaired clearances and made visible at night by electric lights.
- (2) That on September 30, 1928, all impaired clearances herein authorized shall be removed and clearances conforming in all respects to those prescribed
  in the Commission's Decisions No. 18569 and No. 19030,
  in Application No. 9671, be thereafter maintained until further order of the Commission.
