Key System Transit Company, a corporation, Southern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, and Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with the Commission on the 31st day of March, 1928, asking for an order authorizing and approving agreements relating to certain track crossings at grade in the Cities of Emeryville and Berkeley, County of Alameda, and in the City of Richmond, County of Contra Costa, California. Certified copies of said agreements are attached to and made a part of the application. The agreements relate to the apportionment of the cost of maintenance of the following crossings at grade of the single track of Key System Transit Company and the single track of Southern Pacific Railroad Company and operated by Southern Pacific Company.

- (a) At the intersection of Park Avenue and Halleck Street in Emeryville, Alameda County.
- (b) Near the intersection of Ward Street and Shattuck Avenue, in Berkeley, Alameda County.
- (c) In the vicinity of the Pullman Shops in Richmond, Contra Costa County.

It appears to the Commission that the proposed agreements are just and reasonable, that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreements entered into by Key System Transit Company, Southern Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company, dated August 2nd, 1927, and made a part of the application, be and the same are hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
