

Decision No. 13683.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, and SACRAMENTO NORTHERN RAILWAY, a corporation, for an order authorizing and approving an agreement between said Southern Pacific Company, said Sacramento Northern Railway and Libby, McNeill & Libby, providing for the ownership, maintenance and use of certain trackage at Sacramento, California, portions of which are used to serve the industrial plant of said Libby, McNeill & Libby.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, and Sacramento Northern Railway, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 11th day of February, 1928, requesting an order authorizing and approving an agreement previously entered into by the applicants herein and Libby, McNeill & Libby, subject however to the approval of this Commission, relating to the ownership, maintenance and use of certain trackage in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, as shown by the map attached to a copy of the proposed agreement, which is filed with the application and made a part thereof.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a proceeding in which a public hearing is necessary; that the proposed agreement is just and reasonable and not against the public interest, and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore

mentioned, a certified copy of which is attached to the application, be and it is hereby approved and the applicants herein are hereby authorized to carry said agreement into effect on May 1st, 1928.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
