BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, on April 24th, 1928, filed with this Commission a request for permission to operate over the tracks of its Covina Branch for a temporary period with less side and overhead clearances than are prescribed in the Commission's General Order No. 26-C, pending the construction of the overhead crossing of Eastern Avenue with its right-of-way in the County of Los Angeles, as shown on Exhibit "D" attached to the application.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the Pacific Electric Railway Company to operate over said tracks with the impaired clearances set forth in its letter of April 24th, 1928, during the construction of the overhead crossing of Eastern Avenue with the Pacific Electric Railway Company's right-of-way in the

County of Los Angeles, State of California, for a period not to exceed one hundred and fifty (150) days from the date of this order subject, however, to the following condition:

(1) Pacific Electric Railway Company shall place suitable warning signs to be illuminated at night at the points of impaired clearances and also notify trainmen by bulletin of said impaired clearances.

In all other respects, this Commission's order heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
