Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight platform located at Coyote Station, on its Watts-Redondo Beach Line in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (C.E.H. 11156) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no shipments have been handled at this station during the past two years.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company to abandon and remove a freight platform, located at Coyote Station, on its Watts-Redondo Beach Line in Los Angeles County, and as

more definitely shown in yellow on map "C.E.H. 11153" attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
