In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across M Street and three side tracks across O Street, in the City of Merced, County of Merced, State of California.

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, applicant herein, having made written request for a modification of Condition (3) of this Commission's Decision No. 18320, dated May 3, 1927, in the above entitled proceeding, to provide for the manual control of wig-wags required in said Condition between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. daily instead of between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. daily, as required in said Condition (3), and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of said Decision No. 18320, dated May 3, 1927, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) Two wig-wags of type shown as Standard No. 3 or one wig-wag of type shown as Standard No. 4 in General Order No. 75, shall be installed for the protection of said crossing of "M" Street. Existing crossing gates at this street shall be removed. Said wigwags shall be manually controlled between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. daily, and automatically controlled for the remainder of the twenty-four hour period.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 18320, dated May 3, 1927, in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
