SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Whereas the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 19618 ordered that Corcoran Telephone Exchange, a corporation, might file and make effective certain rates as set forth therein, on approval by Supplemental Order, after a showing by Corcoran Telephone Exchange that it had made continuous exchange telephone service available to its patrons, and

Whereas the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Corcoran Telephone Exchange has complied with the condition of the Order in Decision No. 19618, dated April 17, 1928,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Corcoran Telephone Exchange shall

(1) Charge and collect the rates for Exchange telephone service set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" of this Commission's Decision No. 19618 on and after June 1st, 1928.

(2) Cancel all rate schedules, at present effective, which are in conflict with those shown in said Exhibits "A" and "B" of this Commission's Decision No. 19618, effective as of June 1st, 1928.

(3) Submit for filing with the Railroad Commission on or before May 25th, 1928, the rates and map of primary rate area shown in Exhibits "A" and "B", respectively, of this

Commission's Decision No. 19618.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
