SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, H. Campodonico Draying Co., a partnership, has requested, in writing, under date of May 5, 1923, that the Railroad Commission issue an order revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation by the partnership of an auto trucking service for the transportation of freight as a common carrier between San Francisco and Irvington, via San Leandro, granted by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 12045, dated May 8, 1923, and issued on Application No. 8770, and

WHEREAS, said H. Campodonico Draying Co. declares that it is no longer operating as a common carrier but has limited its service to that of a contract carrier, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to H. Campodonico Draying Co. by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 12045 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, with the understanding, however, that the order herein shall in no wise be construed as a determination by the Railroad Commission of the character of the operations of said H. Campodonico Draying Co., and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said H. Campodonico Draying Co. shall immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in its name with said Commission, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
