In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Almond, in Orange County, California.

O R D E R.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed located at the non-agency station of Almond, on its Santa Ana Branch line in Orange County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (F-9875) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the shelter shed herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is constructed on private property adjoining its right-of-way; that there is no longer any passenger train operation on said Santa Ana Branch and that said passenger shelter shed is not now or likely to be required.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its passenger shelter shed located at the non-agency station of Almond, on its Santa Ana line in Orange County and as more definitely shown in yellow on map (F-9875) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
