O R D E R

American Railway Express Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency station known as Devore on the line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in San Bernardino County.

Applicant alleges that express business accruing revenue of \$222.59 was transacted at said station during the annual period ending January 31, 1928, and that in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be, and it is hereby, granted to American Railway Express Company,

a corporation, to abandon its agency station known as Devore located on the line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in San Bernardino County; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said agency station applicant shall continue to serve the public at that point by means of a non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
