O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing it to reduce its station at Ibis on its Arizona Division in San Bernardino County, from an agency station to a non-agency station.

Applicant alleges that \$115.31 passenger business was transacted at the said agency station of Ibis during the annual period ending February 29, 1928; that \$356.66 less than carload business was transacted at said station during said annual period; that no carload freight business was transacted at said station during the same period; that the abandonment of said agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be, and it is hereby, granted to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency station at Ibis located on its Arizona Division in San Bernardino County; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said agency station applicant shall continue to serve the public at that point by means of a non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
