BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, having on May 3, 1928, filed with the Commission a request that Condition No. (3) of the Commission's Decision No. 15,238, dated July 31, 1925, in this application, be modified to permit switching over the crossing granted in this proceeding between the hours of 12:00 noon and 1:00 P.M. daily, in addition to the hours permitted in Decision No. 15,238, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. (3) of Decision No. 15,238, dated July 31, 1925, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing except between the hours of 8:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M., provided that until further order of this Commission, such operation will also be permitted be-

tween the hours of 12:00 noon and 1:00 P.M.

In all other respects this Commission's order heretofore entered in the proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
