## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that C.Lawrence Ritchie and W.W.Wood be and they are hereby authorized to discontinue the business of transporting passengers between San Diego and Warner's Hot Springs and intermediate points, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Lawrence & Wood shall immediately make the necessary tariff filings cancelling rates and rules and regulations covering said passenger service between San Diego and Warner's Hot Springs and intermediate points.
