BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

In this proceeding Vallejo Electric Light and Power Company asks the Railroad Commission to make its order granting applicant permission to make effective a new electric lighting schedule.

A hearing in this matter was held in Vallejo before Examiner Rowell on May 23, 1928. No one appeared to protest the granting of the application.

Witness for applicant testified that the proposed electric lighting schedule will result in reductions, approximating Twenty-five thousand (25,000) dollars per annum. Some slight increases in the bills of a limited number of consumers will result.

The Commission has considered the effect of the schedule which applicant proposes to place in effect and since this schedule will result in an immediate substantial saving to electric lighting and domestic consumers as a

whole, we are of the opinion that this application should be granted.

ORDER

Vallejo Electric Light and Power Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to make effective a certain electric lighting schedule, a public hearing having been held thereon and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that such authority should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective with bills based on regular monthly meter readings taken on and after June 1, 1928, Vallejo Electric Light and Power Company shall charge and collect for electric lighting service the rates set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. Such rate shall be filed with this Commission on or before June 1, 1928.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days on and after the date hereof.

EXHIBIT "A"

SCHEDULE A

(Cancelling Schedule A)

GENERAL LIGHTING SERVICE:-

Applicable to general domestic and commercial lighting service, including household appliances and small power service.

TERRITORY:-

Applicable to all territory served by the Vallejo Electric Light & Power Company.

RATE:-

Base rate 10 cents per kilowatt-hour, subject to the following schedule if paid on or before the 10th day of each month, at the office of the Company:

Service Charge per meter per month . . . . . 50¢

Energy Charge (to be added to Service Charge)

First 200 K.W.H. per meter per month . . . . 5¢ per K.W.H.  
 Next 800 K.W.H. per meter per month . . . . 4¢ per K.W.H.  
 Next 2000 K.W.H. per meter per month . . . . 3¢ per K.W.H.  
All  
 Over 3000 K.W.H. per meter per month . . . 2½¢ per K.W.H.

Minimum Charge: The Service Charge set forth above constitutes the minimum charge.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:-

Single phase motors of an aggregate capacity of 5 h.p. or less may receive service or may be combined with general lighting service under schedule at the option of the consumer, provided, in case of combination service, the total energy is supplied through one meter. The minimum charge applicable to this combination service shall be the same as that set forth above.
