ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Etter on its Shasta Division in Shasta County.

Applicant alleges that no business was transacted at the non-agency station of Etter during the annual period ending February 29, 1928; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities and that in the opinion of applicant the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The Farm Bureau Federation has signified by letter that it has no objection to the abandonment of said non-agency station.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the Southern Pacific Company, a cor-

poration to abandon its non-agency station of Etter, located on its Shasta Division in Shasta County, to eliminate said non-agency station from its station records and cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules to and from said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
