SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Transit Co. be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute a deed of trust substantially in the same form as that filed with the original petition herein and to issue its promissory note or notes, secured thereby, in the aggregate principal amount of \$127,000.00 payable on or before one year after date of issue, with interest at not exceeding six percent. per annum, for the purpose of renewing the note or notes of like amount issued, pursuant to authority granted by Decision No. 18080, dated March 15, 1927, as amended by Decision No. 18261, dated April 20, 1927, provided that the authority herein granted to execute a deed of trust is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted only insofar as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said deed of trust as to such other legal requirement to which said deed of trust may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the orders in Decision No. 18080, dated March 15, 1927 and Decision No. 18261, dated April 20, 1927 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
