Hughes, co-partners, have advised the Railroad Commission, in writing, under date of June 16, 1928, that they have not operated the automotive stage service they were authorized to perform between Chico and Butte City and Princeton by Decisions No. 8039 and No. 7559 since March 7, 1927, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said partners by Decision No. 7559 and Decision No. 8039 be and the same is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission in the name of said partners be, and the same hereby are canceled.
