Applicant herein having advised the Commission that it does not intend to construct the spur track at grade across "D" Street in the City of Brawley, County of Imperial, State of California, heretofore authorized in this proceeding in Decision No. 15873, dated January 18th, 1926, and it appearing that said decision should therefore be revoked and this application dismissed, in so far as they apply to said crossing of "D" Street, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 15873, in so far as it applies to the crossing of "D" Street in the City of Brawley, County of Imperial, State of California, be and it is hereby revoked and Application No. 12423, in so far as it applies to said crossing of "D" Street be and the same is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

In all other respects this Commission's orders heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force

and effect.
