ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, Decision No. 19443 dated March 5, 1928, granted to Pickwick Stages System a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automotive passenger stage service between Los Angeles and Venice over a specified route set forth in said Decision, subject to the condition that applicant should file tariff of rates and time schedules within thirty (30) days from the date thereof, and should commence operation within sixty (60) days from the date thereof, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the above condition has not been complied with;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pickwick Stages System by and under the provisions of said Decision No. 19443 be and the same is hereby revoked.
