BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, by Decision No. 17974, dated February 8, 1927, authorized Ocean Park Heights Water Company, among other things, to issue and sell \$100,000.00 of bonds and to use \$20,000.00 of the proceeds to finance the cost of certain improvements as follows:-

50,000 gallon capacity steel tank and tower . . .	\$6,000.
Pumping equipment, electrical control apparatus and wiring, pipe connections, etc. to be installed at one of the wells now inoperative. . .	3,500.
Distribution pipe lines . . . . .	7,500.
Meters and services . . . . .	<u>3,000.</u>
Total . . . . .	<u>\$20,000.</u>

and,

WHEREAS, applicant reports, in a supplemental petition filed on June 14, 1928, that it still has on deposit \$14,649.67 of said proceeds; that it is impractical and inadvisable to construct

all of said improvements at this time; and that owing to the increased demand for service and the availability of a better source of supply, it has deemed it advisable to purchase, for \$24,000.00, four acres of water bearing land located on Charnock Road between Sawtelle Boulevard and Inglewood Boulevard, and



WHEREAS, it now asks permission to use said \$14,649.67 to finance in part the cost of said land, and


WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission is of the opinion that the use of said proceeds is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein and is not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expense or to income, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 17974, dated February 8, 1927, be, and it hereby is, modified so as to permit Ocean Park Heights Water Company to use \$14,649.67 of the proceeds received through the issue and sale of the bonds therein authorized to be issued and sold, to finance in part the cost of acquiring the four acres of water bearing land referred to herein,

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 17974, dated February 8, 1927, as modified, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
