 and necessity heretofore granted to Smith and Ramsey by Decision  
 No.9059, issued on Application No.6884, and acquired by George A.  
 Scott by said Decision No.14611, be and the same is hereby revoked  
 and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules  
 covering said service filed with the Railroad Commission in the name  
 of George A. Scott be and the same are hereby canceled.
