## ORDER

Manteca Water Works, a corporation selling and distributing water for domestic and other purposes to consumers in and in
the vicinity of the City of Manteca, County of San Joaquin, having
made application to this Commission for authority to sell its water
system to the City of Manteca, a municipal corporation of the sixth
class, which joins in the application, and it appearing that said
City of Manteca has agreed and is willing to assume the obligations of said Manteca Water Works to supply water to all its
present and prospective consumers, both within and without the
corporate limits of said city, and that this is not a matter in
which a public hearing is necessary and that the application
should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Manteca Water Works, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to the City of Manteca, a municipal corporation of the sixth class, for a consideration of approximately \$46,000., plus inventory of stores and supplies on hand at date of transfer, that certain public

utility water system supplying water to consumers in and in the vicinity of said city and as more particularly set forth in Exhibit "E" attached to the application herein and hereby made a part of this order by reference, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the thirtieth (30th) day of September, 1928, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Manteca Water Works, a corporation, within ten (10) days from the date on which it is executed.
- 2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Manteca Water Works, a corporation, actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement setting forth the date on which such control and possession was relinquished.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
