Manteca Water Works, a corporation selling and distribut-
 ing water for domestic and other purposes to consumers in and in
 the vicinity of the City of Manteca, County of San Joaquin, having
 made application to this Commission for authority to sell its water
 system to the City of Manteca, a municipal corporation of the sixth
 class, which joins in the application, and it appearing that said
 City of Manteca has agreed and is willing to assume the obliga-
 tions of said Manteca Water Works to supply water to all its
 present and prospective consumers, both within and without the
 corporate limits of said city, and that this is not a matter in
 which a public hearing is necessary and that the application
 should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Manteca Water Works, a cor-
 poration, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to the City
 of Manteca, a municipal corporation of the sixth class, for a
 consideration of approximately \$46,000., plus inventory of stores
 and supplies on hand at date of transfer, that certain public
