O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Draper on its Shasta Division in Shasta County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at said non-agency station during the annual period ending March 31st, 1928; that no freight business was transacted at said station during the twelve-month period ending February 29th, 1928; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

California Farm Bureau Federation has stated by letter that it has no objection to the abandonment of said non-agency station and it appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Draper, located on

its Shasta Division in Shasta County; to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; and to cancel all rates in freight and passenger tariff to and from said station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
