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The Western Pecific ziliroad Company, a comporation, I110d the above entitied appiication with this comosssion on the 29tin day of June, 1928, askig for authority to constract a passIng track at grade across "A" Streot in the Town of Eaywerd, Compty of Alemeda, and Smset. Bonevard ame Gove Tay in the mon incorporatied portion of the county of ALameda, stato of Celifornia, as bereinetter set forth. The nocessary permits have boen gremted by the Boari of Itustees of said City mad the Board of Supervisors of said county for the constraction of said crossings at grade. It appears to this Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a pubic heering is necessery; that it is neither reascmable nor practicebie at this time to provide grade seperations or to aroid grado crossings at the points menticned in this appi10at10n with said streets and that this application shorid be granted suojeot to the conditions hereinafter specified, theretore,

In IS EHRKESY ORDERED that pexmission and adthority be and 1t is aereby granted to the Western Pacitic Railroed Compory to construot a pessing track at grade across "2" Street in tho Town of

Eayward, county of Alameda, and Sunset Borleverd and Grove Thay in the unincorporated portion of the County of Alameda, State of Coilfomia, at the locations hereinaiter particuiarly described and as shom by the map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application.

## Description of Crossings

BEGINTING at the point of intersection of the comter line of existing track Westorin Pacisic zailrond Company, a corporation, with the southeasteriy inne of "及" Street, in the Tom of Eayward, distant northeasteriy thereon approximately 130 feet from the portheasteriy inne of Grand Street; thence northwesteris along a 10 degree curve to the lort, having a radius of 573.686 teet, an are aistance of approximately 82 feet, crossing the northwesteriy line of sexd "at Street approximately 108 feet northeasterly from the northeasteriy line of safd Grand Street, ortended northwesteriy.
beginoring at a point in the centor inne of the main. Iine traok of mppifcont, distent northwesteriy thereon 9.7 feet from the northwesterly inne of "A" Stroet in the Tow of Eaymard; thence northwesterly along a No. 8-1/2 tumout to the loft o distance of approzimately 210 feot to a point distant 15 feot southwesterly, measured at a right avele from the center line of said main line track; thence northresteriy', is toet from and parailel with said center Ifne, a distance ot 3996.5 Iect, crossing the southeasterly and northwesterly ilnes of Sumset 3oul evard and Grove Way 15 feet soutinesteriy measured at right angles from said center ijne.

The above crossing of "A" Street shail be idontified as
a portion of Crossing NO. 4-20.2.
The above crossing of Sunset Bonlerard shall be identified as a portion or Crossing No. $4-12.8$.

The abore crossing of Greve War shail be identified as a portion of Crossing NO. 4-19.50

Seid crossings to be constructed subject to the followig conditions and not otherwise:
(1) The ontire expense of constracting the crossings, Hogether fith the cost of their maintenence thereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the pabIic, shail bo borme by applicant.
(2) Said crossing of "A" Street shail be constructed equal or-superior to type shown as Stendard No. 3, and said crossings of Sunset Bouleverd and Grove fay shelil be comstructed oqual or superior to type shown as Stenderd No. 2, in Goneral Order No. 72 of this Comission and" shail be constructed of a widin to conform to those portions of seid streets now graded, With the tops of rails at same ol evation as main ine rails and flash with the pavement or roadmay, and with grades of approach not exceeding six (B) per cent; shell be protected by Standerd Kro. I orossing signs, as specitied in General ordez 1 KO .75 of this Commssion, and shail in overy wey be made suitable for the passage thereover of vehioles and other road trafic.
(3) Sald crossing of "A" street shell be protected by an antomatio wig-ras of the type specitied as Standard Ko. 3 in the Comission's General Order No. 75.
(4) Appificant shail, within tilirty (30) days thereatter, notify this comission, in wisitios, of tixe completion of the instaliation of said crossings.
(5) If said crossings shail not havo been instailod Within one year from the date of tinis order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, unless firther time is granted by subsequent order.
(6) The Comassion reserves the rigint to make such further orders, reiative to the location, construction, operation, maintenanoe and protection of said erossings, es to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission it, in its judement, the public convenience and necessity hemsend
such action.
The authority heroin granted shell become effective on the date hereof.
