O P I N I O N

This is an application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement dated May 15, 1928, made and entered into by and between applicant and Sequoyah Country Club, a corporation, located in the foothills of Oakland, California. A copy of this agreement, marked Exhibit "A", is attached to the application.

The agreement provides that applicant will extend its gas mains to the Country Club and render service under its regularly filed Schedule G-1 except as to the minimum charges. The necessary extension of gas mains will cost applicant approximately Five thousand, two hundred and eighty-seven (5,287) dollars, for which the Country Club agrees to pay a minimum charge of Fifteen hundred (1,500) dollars per year for a period of three (3) years from and after completion of the extension. In all other respects, the conditions of service and rates are in accordance with the standard practices of applicant. The

Commission is of the opinion that the agreement is fair to both parties and that a public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to this Commission for an order approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and Sequoyah Country Club, a corporation, dated May 15, 1928, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Corporation and Sequoyah Country Club be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
