SUPPLEMENT ORDER

WHEREAS, E. C. Craig has advised the Railroad Commission, in writing, under date of June 21, 1928, that his contract with the U. S. Government covering transportation of mail between Los Olivos and Gaviota, has been canceled, and

WHEREAS, Decision No. 17638, dated November 18, 1926, granting to E. C. Craig authority to transport passengers between Los Olivos and Gaviota in connection with his mail stage operations, provided that when said mail contract was terminated the authority to transport passengers would become null and void, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to E.C.Craig by Decision No. 17638 be and the same is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that E.C.Craig shall immediately make proper tariff filings cancelling rates and time schedules covering said service between Los Olivos and Gaviota.
