FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, Defendant herein, having in writing requested an extension of time in which to renew timbers in Tunnel No. 5 on its Tiburon to Willits Line, as specified in Decision No. 19527, dated March 30th, 1928, in the above entitled matters, and it appearing to the Commission that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit of the compliance with the Commission's Decision No. 19527, of March 30th, 1928, in so far as it relates to the renewal of timbers in Tunnel No. 5 on Defendant's Tiburon to Willits Line, be and it is hereby extended to

March 30th, 1930.

In all other respects this Commission's order heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
