ORDER

Tonopah and Tidewater Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Tecopa on its main line in Inyo County, California.

Applicant alleges that passenger business was transacted at the agency station of Tecopa during the annual period ending April 30th, 1928, amounting to \$321.80; that less than carload and carload freight business, in amount of \$723.49, was transacted at said station during the same period; that the abandonment of said agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public. Interested shippers have signified by letter that they do not object to the removal of the agent from said Station of Tecopa.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Tonopah and Tidewater Railroad Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Tecopa, located on the main line in Inyo County, State of California, and to eliminate said agency name from its station records; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said agency applicant will continue the operation of said station of Tecopa as a non-agency station and remove none of the facilities therefrom.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
