BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

East Bay Water Company, a corporation, having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer certain non-operative property in the County of Contra Costa, and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the authority should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that East Bay Water Company, a corporation, be, and it is hereby authorized to transfer lots eleven (11) and twelve (12) in Block Two (2) as laid down and designated upon a certain map entitled, "Map of Jennings' East Richmond Terrace," filed in the office of the Recorder of Contra Costa County, State of California on May 15, 1911, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The authority granted herein shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the 31st day of October, 1928.

(2) A certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said East Bay Water Company within thirty (30) days of its execution.

(3) The consideration for the transfer of the above property shall not be urged before this Commission or any public

body as a finding of value for rate fixing or any purpose other than authorized herein.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
