THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In a supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter on July 18, 1928, Palos Verdes Transportation Company asked the Railroad Commission to make an order authorizing it to use \$2,458.60 of the proceeds received through the issue and sale of the stock authorized by Decision No. 14733, dated April 4, 1925, to pay for equipment as follows:-

Ford 1928 Bus, Engine No. 124535, 10 passenger -	\$2,150.00
Second hand Reo, Engine No. 99534, to be used as a substitute motor on either of the two buses now in operation as needed -	250.00
Extra tire and tube -	32.40
Fire Extinguisher -	15.00
Mud chains -	11.20

The Commission has given consideration to the company's request and is of the opinion that the request should be granted as herein provided and that the expenditures herein

authorized are not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expense or to income, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Palos Verdes Transportation Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to use \$2,458.60 of the proceeds received through the issue and sale of the stock authorized by Decision No. 14733, dated April 4, 1925, to finance the cost of the additional equipment referred to herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 14733, dated April 4, 1925, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
