

Decision No. 20087.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of CALIFORNIA TELEPHONE AND LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and W. G. VAN PELT and J. M. O'BRIEN (a majority of the trustees of the express trust known as Clear Lake Company).

O P I N I O N

This is an application of the California Telephone and Light Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement, dated June 22, 1928, made and entered into by and between applicant and W. G. Van Pelt and J. M. O'Brien, trustees of the express trust known as Clear Lake Company. A copy of this agreement, marked "Exhibit A," is attached to the application.

The agreement provides that applicant will furnish, install, operate and maintain certain street lighting facilities along the streets and highways of the Clear Lake Company located in Clear Lake Park Subdivision in Lake County, California, under its regularly filed street lighting schedules. Clear Lake Company agrees to receive such service for a period of five (5) years and guarantees that the total revenue from such service during the five year period shall be not less than One thousand and twenty (1,020) Dollars. The estimated cost of the extension to supply

such service is One thousand two hundred and seventeen (1,217) Dollars. The Commission is of the opinion that the agreement is fair to both parties and that a public hearing in this proceeding is not necessary.

ORDER

California Telephone and Light Company having applied to this Commission for an order approving a certain agreement entered into between applicant and W. G. Van Pelt and J. M. O'Brien, trustees for Clear Lake Company, dated June 22, 1928, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned agreement between California Telephone and Light Company and W. G. Van Pelt and J. M. O'Brien be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
