ORIGINALSUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears that Owens Valley Transportation, Storage and Packing Company has abandoned the automotive passenger stage service it was authorized by the Railroad Commission in Decision No. 7628 to perform between Lone Pine and Keeler, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 18618, issued in Case No. 1817, found said abandonment to be a fact, basing its findings on a stipulation entered into at the hearing in said matter,

Now, therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Owens Valley Transportation, Storage and Packing Company by said Decision No. 7628 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said Owens Valley Transportation, Storage and Packing Company covering service between Lone Pine and Keeler be and the same are hereby canceled.
