SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, C.O. Dangberg and James T. Mc Alee, co-  
partners, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision  
No. 17441, dated October 11, 1926 and issued on Application  
No. 13113, granted a certificate of public convenience and  
necessity to operate an automotive service between Bridgeport  
and Cow Creek and intermediate points, have requested authority  
to discontinue the service and an order of the Commission  
revoking and annulling said certificate on the ground that  
they are financially unable to maintain said service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority to discontinue  
said service be and the same is hereby granted, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate  
of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to  
C.O. Dangberg and J.T. Mc Alee by said Decision No. 17441 be and  
the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Dangberg and Mc Alee  
shall immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements  
to tariffs and time schedules on file in their names cancelling  
said tariffs and time schedules.
