FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Sunland Rural Telephone Company has reported to the Railroad Commission that it has on hand the sum of \$2,126.62 obtained through the issue and sale of the \$15,000.00 of stock authorized by Decision No. 16572, dated April 26, 1926, and has requested permission to use this sum to reimburse its treasury on account of construction expenditures made as follows:-

Central office equipment . . . . .	\$259.62
Station equipment. . . . .	672.16
Exchange lines . . . . .	647.67
General equipment. . . . .	547.17
Total .....	<u>\$2,126.62</u>

The Commission has given consideration to this request and is of the opinion that it should be granted as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sunland Rural Telephone Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to use \$2,126.62 of the proceeds obtained from the issue and sale of the stock authorized by Decision No. 16572, dated April 26, 1926, to reimburse its

treasury and to finance the construction expenditures referred to herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 16572, dated April 26, 1926, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
