

Decision No. 28189.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of
 PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a
 corporation, for an order of the
 Railroad Commission of the State of
 California authorizing applicant to
 withdraw and cancel electric rate
 schedules applicable to service in
 the territory comprising the former
 Stockton Division of the Western
 States Gas and Electric Company and
 to make effective in said territory
 applicant's filed schedules of elec-
 tric rates and charges.

BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks authority to withdraw and cancel electric rate schedules applicable to service in territory comprising the former Stockton Division of Western States Gas and Electric Company, and to make effective in said territory applicant's filed schedules of electric rates applying in its Stockton and Sacramento Divisions; further, to continue furnishing and supplying electric service to those particular consumers who are now actually receiving service under Western States Gas and Electric Company's Schedule I-5 at the rates therein set forth as deviations from existing schedules of rates.

If the application is granted, consumers receiving service for street railway power and overhead street lighting uses will have their gross annual charges reduced by approximately \$6,900.00 while other consumers will not be affected.

The Commission having considered the application and being of the opinion that favorable action is in the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority herein requested be and the same is hereby granted, such authority to become effective upon the date hereof.
