O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Tolenas on its Western Division in Solano County.

Applicant alleges that the principal shipper at this station was the Pacific Portland Cement Company but that said cement plant has discontinued operation and as a result said agency has become unremunerative and that in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said agency is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The principal shippers have signified by letter that they have no objection to the closing of said agency at Tolenas provided an arrangement is made by applicant to handle their business through its agency at Suisun. The California Farm Bureau Federation has also signified by letter that it has no objection to the closing of said agency.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Tolonas, its Western Division in Solano County, provided this station is continued in the company's records as a non-agency station and the tariffs are amended accordingly.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
