OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application filed by the Palos Verdes Transportation Company seeking authority under Section 15 of the Public Utilities Act to place in effect on less than the statutory thirty days' notice a one-way fare of 5 cents between Redondo Beach and points in Palos Verdes Estates as named in its Local Passenger Tariff C.R.C. No. 2, applicable only to children attending an institution of learning.

The present one-way fare for all classes of passengers between Redondo Beach and points in the Palos Verdes Estates is 10 cents. Applicant alleges that this fare places a burden upon school children daily attending institutions of learning, and it is therefore desired to publish the reduced fare of 5 cents effective prior to the present school term, which will commence on or about September 4, 1928.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Palos Verdes Transportation

Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to establish on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public a one-way fare of 5 cents between Redondo Beach and points in the Palos Verdes Estates as named in its Local Passenger Tariff C.R. C. No. 2, applicable only to children attending an institution of learning.
