FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, filed a First Supplemental Application in this proceeding, with this Commission, on the 16th day of July, 1928, asking for the approval of method of placing identification numbers on railroad crossing signs at public crossings, as required by Section 3 of General Order No. 75 of this Commission, in lieu of the method previously proposed and authorized by the Commission under Decision No. 19,263, in this proceeding.

It appears that the proposed method of placing identification numbers should be approved, without prejudice however, to a later determination by the Commission of a standard method of placing such identification numbers, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to place identification numbers on railroad crossing signposts at public crossings, as shown by Exhibit C.E.H. 11,311 attached to the application, in lieu of the method authorized by our Decision No. 19,263, dated

January 20, 1928, in this proceeding, without prejudice, to a further determination by this Commission of a standard method of showing such identification numbers.

In all other respects, this Commission's orders heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
