Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said Ernest E. Kniss by said Decision No. 11434 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of said Ernest E. Kniss and covering said service between Fort Seward and Zenia be and the same are hereby canceled.
